

General Guidelines for Reciprocal Cabin Seat Agreement



Eligibility

US Airways flight attendants are not eligible to sit on UA jumpseats.

- Flight attendants must be qualified and on active status
- Travel with children, family members or pet is not permitted
- Business related travel is not permitted
- Eligible to sit in any open cabin seat

Listing/Check-In

UA-USAir code share status should exempt flight attendants from secondary screening

- Listing must be made Online. Log in to <https://myidtravel.ual.com> utilizing your Global UID and password. Once logged in:
 - Select only yourself as the traveler, then select continue
 - On "Flight Schedule Query" page select JetBlue (B6)
 - Select Flight Attendant commuting listing from the travel status drop down
 - Complete the remaining fields based on your travel needs (economy only), select find flights
 - Continue through the booking process until you receive a confirmation
- You may check-in up to 24 hours prior to departure: Online at www.jetblue.com, kiosk, JetBlue mobile app, or with an airport agent
- You may be subject to secondary screening procedures

Boarding

- Priority is given to revenue customers and JetBlue non-revenue customers. After these customers are processed, you will be boarded based on the time of your check-in within your boarding group.
- Wait for the gate agent to call your name and issue a boarding pass

Identification

- Upon check-in, you must present a valid company ID displaying the word "CREW" with an expiration date and may be required to provide an additional government issued photo ID

Dress Code/ Conduct

- If traveling in uniform, flight attendants are expected to conform to proper and complete uniform requirements
- Flight attendants not in uniform should be in business casual attire. No denim, athletic shoes or open toed shoes are allowed
- Once onboard, you must reflect a professional, businesslike attitude in accordance with all standard passenger regulations

Baggage

- Compliance with all approved JetBlue carry-on baggage policies

Alcohol

- Flight attendants in uniform may not consume alcoholic beverages onboard when utilizing the Reciprocal Cabin Seat Agreement

Embargoes

- JetBlue reserves the right to impose an embargo prohibiting travel on certain dates or routings at any time

Destinations

- All domestic and international destinations
- Flight attendants are responsible for payment of any applicable taxes or fees
